**Policy Statement of Punjab Pharmacy Council on 26th (First Year)
Examination of Pharmacy Technician Sessions 2021-2023 & 2022-2024 Result**

Reference to the display of negative propaganda on some social media against the PPC in connection with poor result percentage in the 26th Examination of Pharmacy Technician session 2021-23 & 2022-24 held on 06th January 2024 & 28th January 2024. This propaganda is strongly rejected by NTS / PPC on the basis of following statistics:

- **Total candidates enrolled for the subject examination were over 65000 candidates. Out of these almost 20% candidates were absent in the examination.**
- **Over 15000 candidates out of present candidates could not get 5 or more marks in the theory paper.**
- **Around 5000 candidates could not get even a single mark in the theory paper as majority of students submitted the blank answer sheets.**
- **Not even a single complaint on the Paper content regarding any out of syllabus question.**

The delay in the announcement of the result was due to various rounds of practical's conducted by PPC in the respective colleges/cities across Punjab, AJK and Islamabad which took 6 months to complete and subsequently delayed the announcement of final result. NTS Result was ready on 29th May 2024. All propaganda regarding delay by NTS due to payment issue is fabricated and beyond facts. However, the present poor % age of pass result is a question mark on the quality of education delivered by colleges to their students due to loss of interest / absentee of students / poor competency of faculty and provision of insufficient labs / chemicals facilities.

Keeping in view the poor quality of education delivered to pharmacy technician students and insufficient lab facilities, poor % age of pass result, loss of interest of students, the pharmacy technician college's administration is hereby directed to improve the standards / quality of teaching / faculty / lab facilities according to the approved syllabus / curriculum and requirements of Pharmacy Council of Pakistan (PCP). Otherwise your performance / status of laboratories / chemicals / faculty / present result will be sent to PCP for review / cancellation of NOC granted to pharmacy technician colleges by PCP to impart Pharmacy Technician diploma study course.
